Effortlessly access and navigate through different segments of your organization.

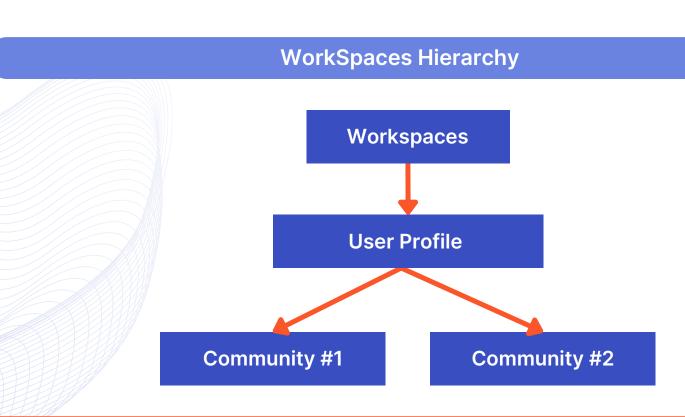

Registration and Login Process

Streamlined Member Registration and Authentication for Enhanced Security.

Pre-Workspaces

 Members of multiple communities previously had to login separately to each one.

Post-Workspaces

- Members of multiple communities will now have a centralized login.
- Registration and authentication now occur at the workspace level.
- For workspaces with mixed authentication, members must authenticate using each authentication method before gaining full access to the workspace.

Why?

Centralized authentication simplifies member management and ensures consistent security standards.

Additional Information:

- For workspaces that utilize a combination of authentication methods, members may be required to authenticate using each unique authentication method during their initial login. This ensures they have proper access to each community in the workspace.
- Workspaces with only a single community will not have their login process impacted and will not have to worry about changes for the mixed authentication use case.
- Post-workspaces, users will be prompted to re-accept all cookies, including the "Remember Me" cookie.
- If member approval is enabled, the workspaces admin will need to approve the member.

Enhanced Privacy Controls for Community Members

Give your community members greater control over their personal information with our privacy features.

Pre-Workspaces

 The "Hide my Identity" option was available on the registration page only when enabled by community admins.

Post-Workspaces

- Workspace Level: The "Hide my Identity" feature is not available at the workspace level. This means that users cannot hide their identity throughout the entire workspace.
- Community Level: Community admins still have the option to allow members to hide their identity at the community level. This provides flexibility in managing privacy settings within individual communities.

Why?

Tailored Privacy: This change offers more granular control over privacy settings, allowing you to balance the needs of your community members with the overall security and transparency of your workspace.

Introducing a New Role: Workspace Owner

Workspace Owners are members who have the ability to edit and manage both the workspace and its communities.

Additional Information:

- The Workspace Owner will initially be set as the existing account owner, but this can be changed.
- The Workspace Owner also serves as the default workspace admin and can assign additional workspace admins as needed.

Member Approval

Enhanced Member Approval Workflow for Greater Control.

Pre-Workspaces

 Member approvals were conducted at the community level.

Post-Workspaces

- Workspace Level: Workspace admins now have the option to enable member approvals at the workspace level, providing greater control over who can join your workspace.
- Community Level: Community admins and global moderators can still approve or reject members at the community level, allowing for tailored approval processes.

Why?

Clearly defined roles and responsibilities ensure a smooth approval process. You also have the flexibility to enable or disable member approvals at both the workspace and community level, making it easier to manage your community's membership.

Customization

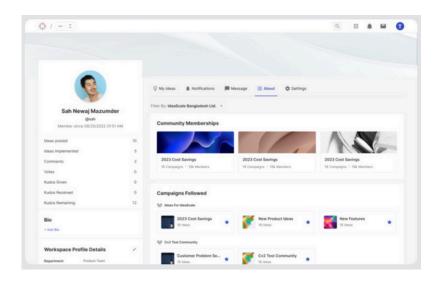
While some customization options have changed, we've focused on maintaining essential features.

Pre-Workspaces

- Security Polices were at the community level.
- Admins were able to choose background image for login.

Post-Workspaces

- Security policies are on the workspace level and configurable by workspace admin.
- We've updated our login page for improved accessibility. While background images are no longer supported, the login text remains customizable.
- You can only have one favicon per workspace and the same favicon will be used across all communities.

Pre-Workspaces

Users had a unique profile page per community.



Post-Workspaces

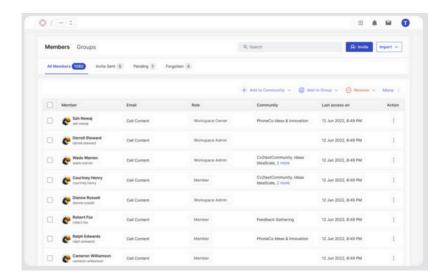
- Workspace-Level Profiles: Users now have a unique profile page per workspace, providing a centralized view of their activities and memberships.
- Community Filtering: The profile page includes a filter option to view details specific to individual communities.

Additional Information:

- The "Activity" page items have been moved to the "About" page for better organization.
- The "My Ideas Action Items" tab has been moved to the first position to help users easily find all their action items.

Pre-Workspaces

 Member management and group management were separate processes.

Post-Workspaces

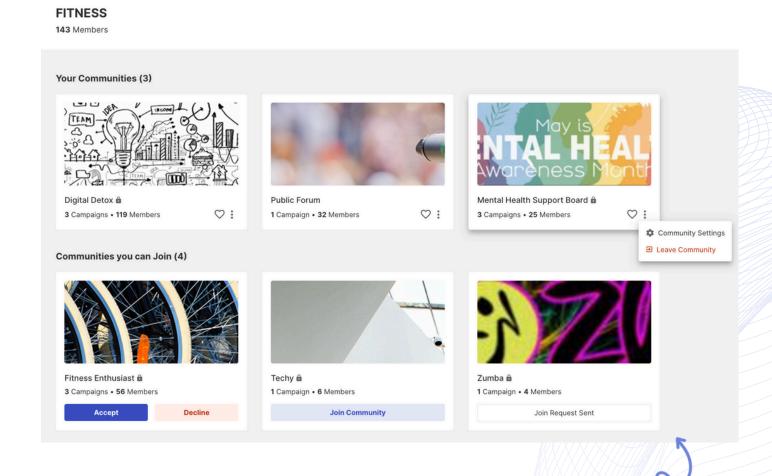
- The updated design combines member details with a dedicated Group tab for managing groups.
- Member management is now available on two levels: community and workspace, and admins can switch between them here.
- Workspace-Level Groups: Groups created at the workspace level can be utilized across multiple communities, promoting collaboration and consistency.
- It is possible to enable approvals at both the workspace and community levels. Communities will have the authority to approve, reject, or ban members within their own community.

Why?

- Improved Efficiency: The streamlined design and enhanced features make it easier for community administrators to manage members and groups.
- Enhanced Collaboration: The ability to create and use workspace-level groups fosters collaboration across multiple communities.

 - Favorite star to prioritize selected communities.
- 3 dots for options:
 - Community Settings
 - Leave Community
- Active members and campaigns display for each community.

Key Features

Communities You Can Join:

This section will display public communities available for joining, private communities to which the user has been invited, and private communities that allow members to request to join.

Community Discovery:

Search bar for easily finding communities and members.

• Displays communities a user can join, has been invited to, or declined.

Topbar Navigation:

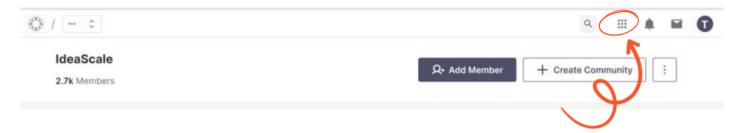
9-Dot Apps Menu for accessing all apps (content varies based on user permissions).
